



How to play Lil Krishna Bingo

Prepare: Print out different bingo cards for each child and the call sheet. Cut out the pictures on the call sheet and put them into a hat or bowl.




Distribute: Hand out one Bingo card to each child (each card should be different). Give each child small objects (such as pennies) to mark the images on their cards.

Call: The caller should pull out one image, describe it and show it to the children.

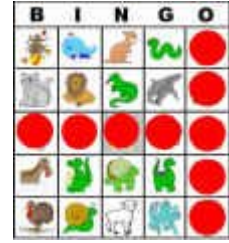
Mark Image: The children will then place pennies, rocks, fun foam pieces or something similar on the called image if it is on their card.

Winning: Once a predetermined pattern (see next page for ideas) is made on a card, the child with that card calls out "Krsna!"

Ideas for bingo patterns:

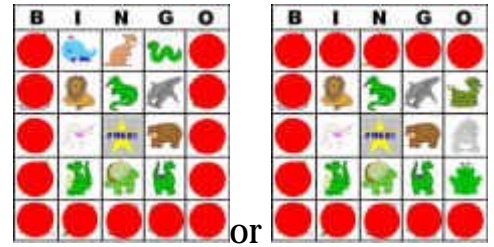
Description	Example
<p>BLACKOUT BINGO</p> <p>All images must be marked to win.</p>	
<p>LINES BINGO</p> <p>Must make a horizontal, diagonal OR vertical line to win</p>	
<p>T's BINGO</p> <p>Fill the card in the shape of a right-side up, upside down or sideways capital T. For example... fill the center column plus the top row.</p> <p>We use this pattern during our daughter Tasha's birthday. We call it Tasha BINGO. You could use the same idea at</p>	

Thanksgiving and call it "Turkey" BINGO...



U's BINGO

Fill the card in the shape of a right-side up, upside down or sideways U. For example... fill the left and right most columns and the top row.



SQUARES BINGO

Fill the card in the shape of a square (top, left, right and bottom).
